As the only Caribbean island with an E-2 visa treaty with the United States of America, Grenadian citizenship provides investors with a seamless route to live and work in the US. With visa-free travel to China, Russia, the UK, and the Schengen area, citizens of Grenada enjoy increased global mobility and endless opportunities for their families and businesses.

WHY CHOOSE GRENADA?

- Fast processing within 4 months
- Inclusion of dependent children under 30
- Inclusion of dependent parents or grandparents above 55 and/or unmarried siblings 18 years or older with no kids
- No physical residency requirements
- No requirements to travel to Grenada during the application process

- Visa-free travel to over 130 countries, including the UK, Europe's Schengen zone, and China
- E-2 treaty signed between Grenada and the United States allows citizens of Grenada to operate a substantial business in the U.S and reside therein
- No tax on worldwide income
- Citizenship can be passed down to future generations
- Investment can be sold to another Grenadian citizenship investor after 5 years

QUALIFICATIONS

To qualify for citizenship in Grenada, applicants must fulfill one of the investment options and meet the following criteria:

- Be of outstanding character
- Have no criminal record
- Enjoy excellent health
- Possess a high personal net worth



INVESTMENT OPTIONS

The Grenada Citizenship by Investment Program offers two primary investment options for applicants:

1. National Transformation Fund Donation

- **Minimum Contribution:** \$150,000 for a single applicant, \$200,000 for a family of two to four, and \$25,000 for each additional dependent.
- **Family Composition:** The investor's spouse, children under 30, siblings over 18, and parents of any age are eligible to participate in the program.
- **Due Diligence Fees:** \$5,000 per person aged 17 or older.
- **Other Fees:** Government fees, legal services, and document shipping costs.

2. Real Estate Investment

- **Minimum Investment:** \$220,000 for a single applicant, with no obligation to visit or reside on the island.
- **Family Composition:** The main applicant can include an unlimited number of eligible dependents, including siblings, children, and parents.
- **Additional Fees:** Government fees, due diligence fees, and passport fees.
- **Resale:** The property must be held for at least five years if it is resold as a qualifying investment to another citizenship by investment investor.

Key Benefits

- Visa-free travel to over 153 countries, including China, Russia, the UK, and the Schengen Area.
- E-2 Treaty Investor Visa for up to five years, allowing citizens to live and work in the USA.
- No tax on worldwide income.
- Citizenship transferable to new spouses and future generations.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- **Processing Time:** Three to four months.
- **Government Fees:** \$5,000 per person aged 17 or older.
- **Interview Fees:** \$1,000 per person and each qualified dependent aged 17 or older.
- **Application Processing Fees:** \$1,500 per person and each qualified dependent aged 18 and over.

ADDITIONAL COSTS

- **Due Diligence Fees:** \$5,000 per person aged 17 or older.
- **Other Fees:** Government fees, legal services, and document shipping costs.
